

➤ **Bridging Academic Institutions (ACBRIDGE)**

The aim of the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) funded project was to promote inter-university co-operation through academic mobility and to enhance the quality of teaching and research in African universities. Four students including three Ghanaians and one German were awarded scholarships to pursue PhD programmes. Prof. Richard Adanu was the lead investigator at the School of Public health and the total grant money was EUR 1,967,272.00. The students have completed their doctorate programmes.
