## Impact Assessment of the Rural Response System to Reduce Violence Against Women in Ghana

This project is being funded by United Kingdom Government's Department for International development (DFID) with support from the South African Medical Research Council with an amount of \$630,000. This is a three year project (2015 - 2018) led by Prof. Richard Adanu. The goal is to reduce the prevalence of VAW and promote and protect the rights of women and girls. This will be done by increasing the visibility of VAW as a social issue, improving the public's knowledge and understanding of its negative impact of VAW on the status of women and girls; establish a community based response system for the support and protection of women and provide counselling services as well as work with state agencies to ensure effective response to victims; whilst sharing best practice and key lessons learnt with other stakeholders. The collaborators are Dr. Adolphina A. Addo-Lartey and Dr. Deda Ogum Alangea both of the School of Public Health.
