Sustainable Sanitation Ghana (SUSA)

The overall objective of the SUSA project since its inception in 2011 was to identify existing barriers to improved sanitation. The study also developed business models for providing hygienic latrine technologies and waste management solutions that can be used in poor, rapidly urbanizing townships in Ghana. The strategy that was used to achieve this is the training of PhDs with a multidisciplinary approach to answer the objectives of the project. Dr. Mawuli Dzodzomenyo and Prof. Moses Aikins were the lead investigators at the School of Public Health for the environmental health and policy streams.
